Arrangements for the day

Deene Park is a large sixteenth-century house incorporating a medieval manor and has important rooms added during the reign of George III. It has belonged to the Brudenell family since 1514. Today, the House is the home of Robert and Charlotte Brudenell and their son, William.

The House is located off the A43 between Corby and Stamford and is signposted from the main road.

Please aim to arrive between 10.15 am and 10.30 am for refreshments in the Old Kitchen Tea Room.

As you will be making your own way to Deene Park, we encourage members to car-share and/or offer a lift to someone else so that some who may not drive or don't want to drive, can join in the visit. There is plenty of free parking on site.

The tour of the House is over 2 floors and will start promptly at 11am and last an hour and a half.
